If you are selected for an audition you will be asked to prepare a monologue in English, preferably from a play or screenplay lasting no longer than 2 minutes. The audition panel (Matthew Lloyd, Aurelia Nolin) will not accept songs, poems or self-written pieces.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

Tuition for European ACT is currently valued at **£4350** for applicants from countries which offer funding and financial support for artists seeking professional development. The Actors Centre Scholarship scheme is devised for those actors who have no access to other sources of sponsorship to benefit from the programme at the reduced cost of £1400/**Euro equivalent**. Scholarships apply to tuition only. All travel, housing and living expenses are the responsibility of the individual. Applicants will be assessed for scholarships as part of the audition process unless they answer "NO" below.
